Paving Standards in Public Right-of-Way

- Driveways shall be at least 6" thick concrete over a 6" compacted sand base
- Sidewalks shall be at least 4" thick concrete over a 4" thick compacted sand base
- Concrete shall be 4000 PSI, reinforced with polypropylene fibers (1 ½ one-pound bags per cubic yard of concrete)
