8 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
9 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
10 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
11 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as
12 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2022.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell,
14 Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax of 26.09
15 mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana,
16 situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City, in the calendar year
17 2021.
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21 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
22 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:

24 A tax of 4.88 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues
25 to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal
26 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as authorized by
27 Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27.
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31 A tax of 2.88 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
32 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as
33 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on
34 November 19, 2013.

4 A tax of 2.05 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
5 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as
6 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on April 4,
7 1981.

10 A tax of 3.85 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in
11 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as authorized by the special taxpayer
12 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on November 19, 2013.

14 A tax of 4.72 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of
15 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as authorized by the special taxpayer
16 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on November 19, 2013.

18 A tax of 1.93 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving
19 public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as authorized by the
20 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on April 4, 1981.
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22 A tax of 2.20 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
23 interest and maturing bonds for the 2010 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,
24 Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as authorized by a special election held October 17, 2009,
25 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and Council Members of the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
26 passed on the 28th day of July, 2009.
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28 A tax of 2.92 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
29 interest and maturing bonds for the 2016 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,
30 Louisiana, for fiscal year 2022, as authorized by a special election held April 9, 2016 and
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

13 on October 17, 2009 and as refunded by Ordinance No. 3803 on the 8th of March, 2016.
